RRT results in 37%
reduction in post-
operative deaths

RRT results in
50% reduction
in cardiac
arrests outside
ICU

Triggers for Calling the Rapid Response Team in the Hospital:

- 1- Change in Heart Rate
- 2- Change in Oxygenation
- 3- Change in Respiratory Rate
- 4- Change in Blood Pressure
- 5- Signs of Hemorrhage
- 6- Decrease in Urine Output
- 7- Decreased level of consciousness/ Onset of agitation/ Delirium, or Seizures
